## **INVITATION FOR BIDS**

Millcreek Township will receive sealed bids labeled for the Millcreek Township Sidewalk Accessibility Project-Phase VI until 3:00 PM, Monday, June 11, 2018, at the office of the Millcreek Township Supervisors, Millcreek Township Municipal Building, 3608 West 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Erie, PA 16506-2037, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids are invited for the following: Removal, design and replacement of 131 sidewalk ramps/blended transitions divided among 31 locations along 14 roads in Millcreek Township, Erie County, PA. Bid will also include the bituminous transition from the new ramp to the existing roadway. All ramps, bituminous transitions and safety barricading of ramps under construction must be in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and the 2011 Proposed Accessibility Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way, published in the Federal Register for public comment on July 26, 2011. Bidder will supply a separate Lump Sum price along with an item breakdown.

Contract Documents, including drawings and technical specifications, may be reviewed /obtained at the office of the Millcreek Township Engineering Department, 3608 West 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Erie, PA 16506, (814-833-6096) for a non-refundable deposit of \$25.00. Addenda, if any, will be issued to only those persons whose name and address are on record as having obtained the Contract Documents.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid guarantee in the form of a certified or cashier's check or bid bond with corporate surety payable to Millcreek Township in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid price.

The project is being carried out with Community Development Block Grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development. The bidder's attention is called to the federal and state civil rights and equal employment opportunity requirements; MBE/WBE and Section 3 Compliance Requirements; and the requirement to pay Davis Bacon Wage Rates and comply with applicable labor standards provisions, all as set forth in the Contract Documents.

Bids may be held by the Township for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of opening bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of bidders prior to awarding the contract. Bids shall be announced at the meeting of the Board of Supervisors on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at the Municipal Building. Award of contract will be done after all submissions have been reviewed.

Millcreek Township reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities or minor deviations in the bidding.
