FY 2018-FY 2022 FIVE-YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND FY 2018 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS
Notice is hereby given that the Township of Milcreek, Pennsylvania will be applying for FY 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the approximate amount of \$230,000. The Township intends to submit its Five Year (FY 2018-FY 2022) Consolidated Plan and FY 2018 Annual Action Plan to HUD on or before May 16, 2018 and to begin its federal FY 2018 CDBG program on or about July 1, 2018. In accordance with the Final Rule for revised program regulations, 24 CFR, Parts 91, et. al. and the adopted Milcreek Township Citizen Participation Plan, the Township intends to conduct public needs hearings to obtain information related to housing and community development needs and input on the development of proposed activities.

Both hearing locations are handicap accessible and both are on the first floor of their buildings. The public is invited to attend these meetings and provide input on the plan.
The purpose of the Township's Five Year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan is to help to improve the housing and living conditions of its residents, especially the very low and lower income households, homeless persons and persons with special needs; upgrade and improve the public and community facilities in the Township; improve and expand the public services for the residents of Milcreek; and promote economic development opportunities for all residents.
The purpose of the public needs hearings is to:
1. Obtain the views and comments of individuals and organizations concerning the Township's housing and community development needs. The information gathered will be used in the preparation of the Consolidated Plan submission for the FY 2018 Program Year.
2. Review the Township's Community Development Block Grant Program.
3. Summarize the Consolidated Plan process and obtain the views of citizens, public agencies and others interested in the housing and community development needs of the Township.
In order to address any identifiable needs of the Township of Milcreek, the FY 2018-FY 2022 Five Year Consolidated Plan and FY 2018 Annual Action Plan will include various CDBG eligible activities such as:
A. Public Facilities & Improvements
B. Fair Housing and Homebuyers Initiatives
C. Infrastructure Improvements
D. Street/Sidewalk Improvements
E. Accessibility Improvements
F. Administration
